



## Governance Diversity Within Arts Organisations Seminar

Welcome to our seminar on diversity in governance of arts organisations.

*Board diversity is a mixed bag: Arts Boards generally have a good gender balance, and are inclusive of older people, arts consumers and LGBTI people, but many lack representation by young people, people with disability, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people, and people from culturally and linguistically diverse communities. This seminar will present evidence from surveys into diversity in arts governance in Australia, along with a business case, benefits and impact for creating more diverse boards and committees of management. Once the business case has been established the presenter will outline key actions that may be taken by Boards and Committees to improve diversity in governance and leadership.

This seminar has been designed for board or committee members and CEO's in a belief that for arts organisations to incorporate diversity in the workplace then first the Board should set an example through implementation of its own diversity policy.
